 symptoms of a remitting char-
 -acter and progressive emaciation
 The prognosis is seldom favour-
 -able. as the patient is usually
 either suddenly destroyed by the
 violence of inflammation, or
 else it terminates in suppuration
 ulceration, or gangrene. If the
 symptoms are very mild and
 proper remedies be employed
 at an early period of the disea-
 -se, it may terminate in resolu-
 -tion. and that in the course
 of the first or second week.
 If it terminates in suppuration
 it may be known by the symp-
 -toms although moderate exceeding
