Dear Father

I have just rec^d. your letter of the 27th & Mother's of June 21st & 26th. I have not yet seen Mr. Zuberbin (is that the way he spells his name?) but as he doubtless got his letter also by this steamer, he will probably call tomorrow or next day. As you already know I have drawn \$75- by Mr. Williams, & I think that sum will carry me through & home, so that I shall not need to take any money from Mr. Z. - certainly not at present. I am very much obliged to you & Mr. Frank for the letter however as in case I should need any thing I shall know where to apply. I think it very probable that he may be able to help me as regards a steamer when I am able to leave here for N. Y. I have not the least doubt but what I shall receive free passage, but he can give me information as to the best steamer &c. I shall leave here as soon as possible - as soon as I feel able to stand the voyage. The Doctor has ordered me to drink wine two or three times per day & as the little I had is about used up now I shall see if Mr. Z. can put me in the way of getting
