The national 4-H safety program, conducted by the Cooperative Extension Service and supported for a quarter-century by General Motors, enrolls about a half million youths annually between the ages of nine and 19 years. The remaining 2.5 million 4-H'ers throughout the nation also apply safety practices to many projects, according to the National 4-H Service Committee.
