

It not unfrequently happens, that this disease is attended with acute pains darting through the head; This symptom indicates deep seated inflammation, and approaching blindness. Sometimes the patient imagines that he sees substances floating before the pupil, accompanying this symptom is the dilated pupil, the harbinger to paralysis of the optic nerve. In the progressive stages of conjunctival inflammation, ulcers sometimes form on the cornea, through which protrudes the iris, the inflammation already present unites the protruded membrane to the surrounding cornea, and form one species of Staphyloma. Again it happens in conjunctival inflammation, that abscesses form between the laminae of the cornea, which burst and discharge into the anterior chamber, which becomes in time inspissated and resembles in appearance very much, the white spots on the nails of the fingers, from which circumstance, it has received the name of myopia. The matter which produces myopia is small in quantity, but when a larger portion of pus is formed and the anterior chamber, filled with matter, the appearance has been called by Mr. Saunders Hypopygium. That abscesses form in the transparent cornea, we will not deny. But that it becomes inspissated
