

entered they brought credits in the subjects from some other institution, must offer an equivalent number of credits in some other subject or subjects.

No student in the College of Agriculture will be permitted to take more than 16 hours work per week, exclusive of Military Science and Physical Training, except by special permission of the faculty of the College of Agriculture.

Credit will not be allowed students for summer work except by special arrangement in advance with the head of a department. Not more than 6 credits will be allowed for thesis work. In case a student is assigned thesis work, the subject for the thesis must be assigned by the first of June of the junior year, and all theses must be completed and handed in for inspection before fifteenth of May of the senior year.

All candidates for the degree of Bachelor of Science in Agriculture must, by the beginning of the junior year, select a major study in one of the departments of the College of Agriculture. In the schedule of studies given below, courses required for graduation are starred. All other subjects are electives, under the advice and direction of the professor in charge of the work which the student may select as his major study, subject to the approval of the Dean. At least one-half of the electives are to be taken from courses in the College of Agriculture.
