Dear Mother

I have this morning received a letter from my son - the letter was dated Vienna June 7th. I will copy the portion that I think will interest you - Just after I had finished my last letter dated at this place, our men were attacked at Franklin. But we were ordered to return, and reinforce them - We started in answer, when within five miles of Franklin, we encountered Cammings Rebel Cavalry Brigade. We fought them about two hours, when they left the field. As the fight commenced Col. Cooper - who was riding a very wild, unmanageable horse was thrown, and severely injured. My company was passing at the time, going into the fight
