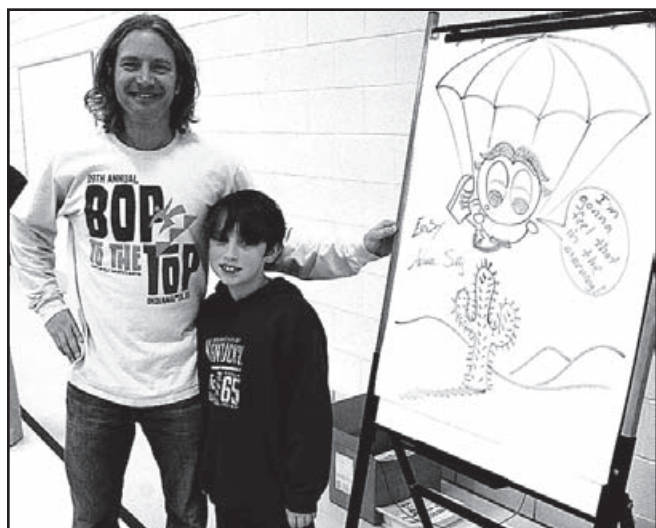
A visit with Andy
