**ESQ. GOVERNOR OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA:**

**TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:**

KNOW YE, That by virtue and in consideration of a land office Treasury warrant N<sup>o</sup> 1018 and filed the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1779. unto *Jacob Froman*

there is granted by the said Commonwealth, unto

*the said Jacob Froman*

a certain TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND, containing *five hundred acres by survey bearing date the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January 1753. lying and being in the County of Jefferson on the Beech fork and adjoining a survey of 25 acres of Paul Fromans on the upper side and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a South East corner of the same a hony locust and Walnut on the bank of the Beech fork thence N<sup>o</sup> 10<sup>o</sup> East and about 10 poles above the mouth of Lick Creek thence East 206 poles up the river to an ash and hickory on the bank of the Beech fork thence N<sup>o</sup> 10<sup>o</sup> East 140 poles to Lick Creek a Sugar tree and white oak thence West 206 poles to a sweet gum and hick on Lick Creek thence S<sup>o</sup> 10<sup>o</sup> West 280 poles to Paul Fromans survey of 50 acres with the line of the same to his 25 acre survey thence a line of the same to the Beginning*

With its appurtenances: To have and to hold the said TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND, with its appurtenances, to the said *Jacob Froman*

and *his* heirs forever.

In Witness Whereof, The said *Patrick Henry* Esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the lesser seal of the said Commonwealth to be affixed, at *Picksmond* on the *Second* day of *December* in the year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred and *eighty five*, and of the Commonwealth the *tenth*.
