



## KEITH BOGANS

Tennessee (2/1/00), 21 against South Carolina (2/5/00) and 24 at No. 12 Florida, including 19 in the second half, to average 23.3 ppg during the three-game stretch... It was a career effort vs. the Vols: 25 points on 8-of-17 shooting, including 4-of-9 from 3-point range, five assists and two steals... His 25 points were the most by a UK freshman since Rod Rhodes in 1992-93... Tallied a team-high 16 points vs. Miami... His consecutive string of free throws made ended at 15... Break-out game came against Maryland in the Preseason NIT, finishing with 17 points, including a 6-of-7 performance from the foul line... Scored his first collegiate points vs. Utah.

### ● HIGH SCHOOL

A first-team McDonald's and *Parade* All-American and named "Prep Player of the Year" by *Basketball Times*... Also picked second-team All-American by *USA Today*... Lettered all four years for legendary coach Morgan Wootten... For four straight years, picked All-Washington Catholic Athletic Conference, All-Metro and made the All-Tournament team at the prestigious Alhambra Invitational, becoming the first player to achieve that feat at the Alhambra Invitational... He's the only Stag to play varsity all four years other than former star Adrian Dantley... Averaged 12.7 points and 3.6 rebounds per game as a freshman, 18.5 ppg, 4.3 rpg and 3.7 apg as a sophomore, 19.2 ppg, 6.0 rpg and 2.3 apg as a junior and 17.9 ppg, 7.0 rpg and 2.3 apg as a senior... The Stags were the top high school team in the nation prior to his senior year, before finishing with a 28-4 record and a No. 6 ranking overall in the *USA Today* poll... As a junior, his squad finished with a 34-1 record and a No. 3 national ranking and he was named a second-team *Parade* All-American and MVP of the City title game... After his senior year, participated in the McDonald's All-America game where he tallied 19 points, five rebounds and five assists... Followed up with 14 points, 10 boards and three assists in the Magic Johnson All-Star game... Chose Kentucky over North Carolina, Michigan and Connecticut.

### ● SMITH ON BOGANS

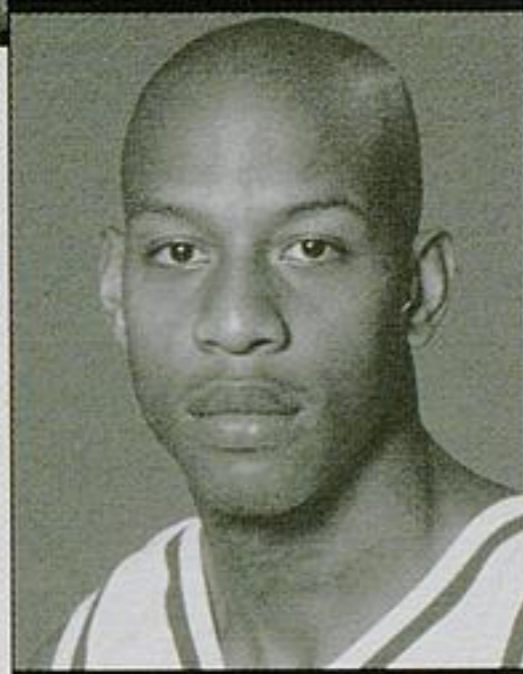

### ● GENERAL

Returning starter at shooting guard... Can play either guard position and small forward, with shooting guard his natural position... The team's second-leading returning scorer... Averaged 15.5 ppg in NCAA Tournament play last season... All-America potential... Serving on the NABC Student Basketball Council that gives student-athletes voice in basketball issues... Last name pronounced "BOE-gans."

### ● 1999-00

Named to the All-SEC Freshman Team... Played in every game with 23 starts, earning his first start vs. Louisville... Set the UK freshman record for steals in a season with 47, breaking the mark of 45 held by Chris Mills (1989)... Finished third on the team in scoring (12.5 ppg) and second in SEC play (13.7 ppg)... Scored in double figures 20 times, including 15 of the last 17 games... Earned the team's Freshman Leadership Award... Topped 20 points five times, including twice against Arkansas... Tied his career best with a game-high 25 points, hitting four-of-six three-point attempts, in the loss to the Hogs in the SEC Tournament... In the regular-season meeting with the Razorbacks, scored a game-high 22 points while matching his career-high nine rebounds... Against SEC competition, finished 13th in scoring, ninth in three-pointers made (1.9 pg) and tied for eighth in steals (1.6 spg)... Also scored at least 20 in three consecutive games, only the second Wildcat freshman to accomplish that feat since freshmen became eligible in 1972-73... Tallied 25 points against No. 6
