The **College of Humanistic Studies** offers opportunities for both traditional and innovative studies of language, literature, philosophy, and those social sciences which have humanistic aspects.

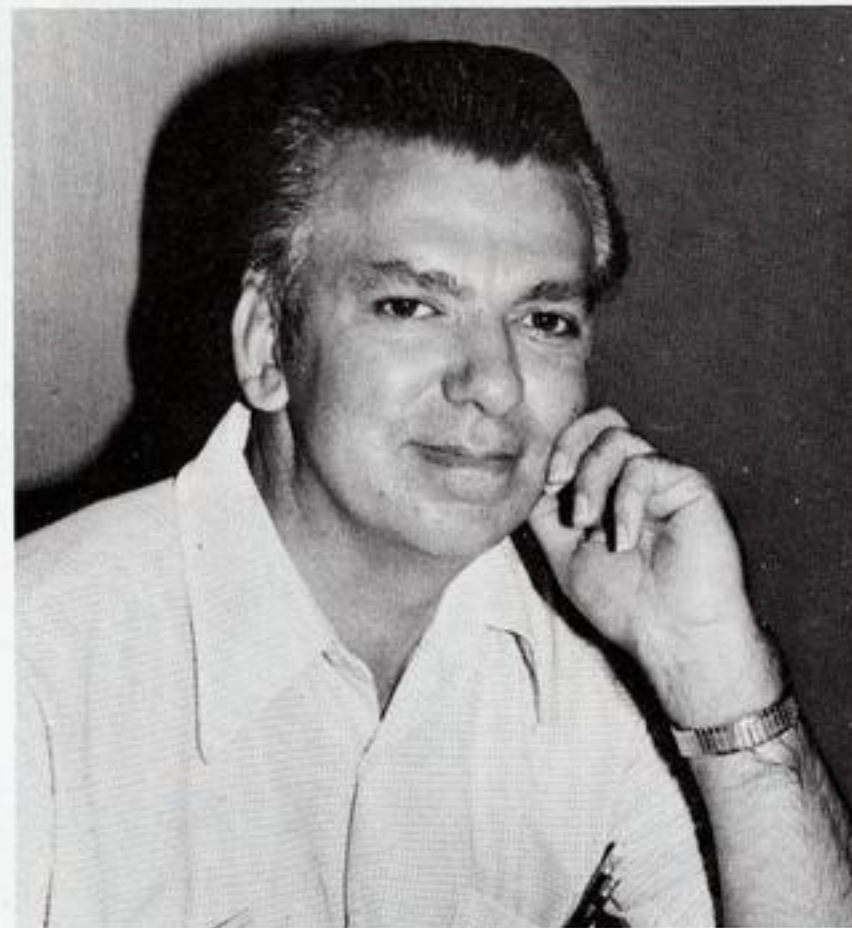

Each department offers undergraduate and graduate degrees.

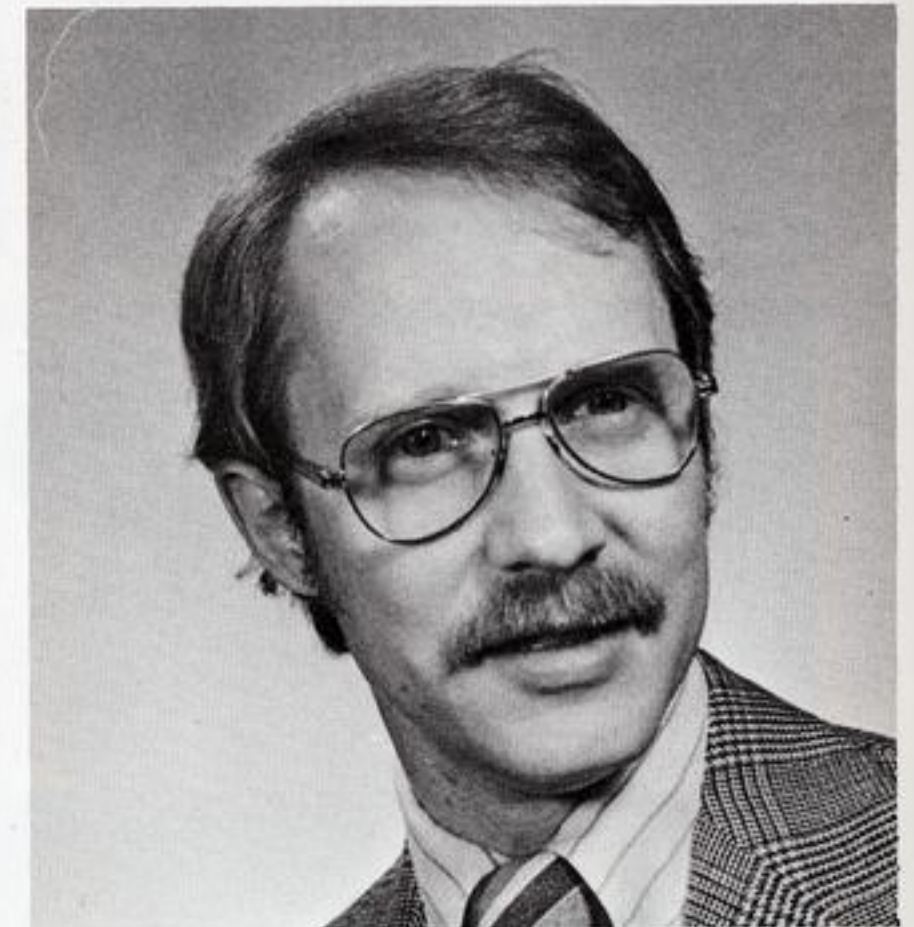
The college is composed of 59 faculty members.



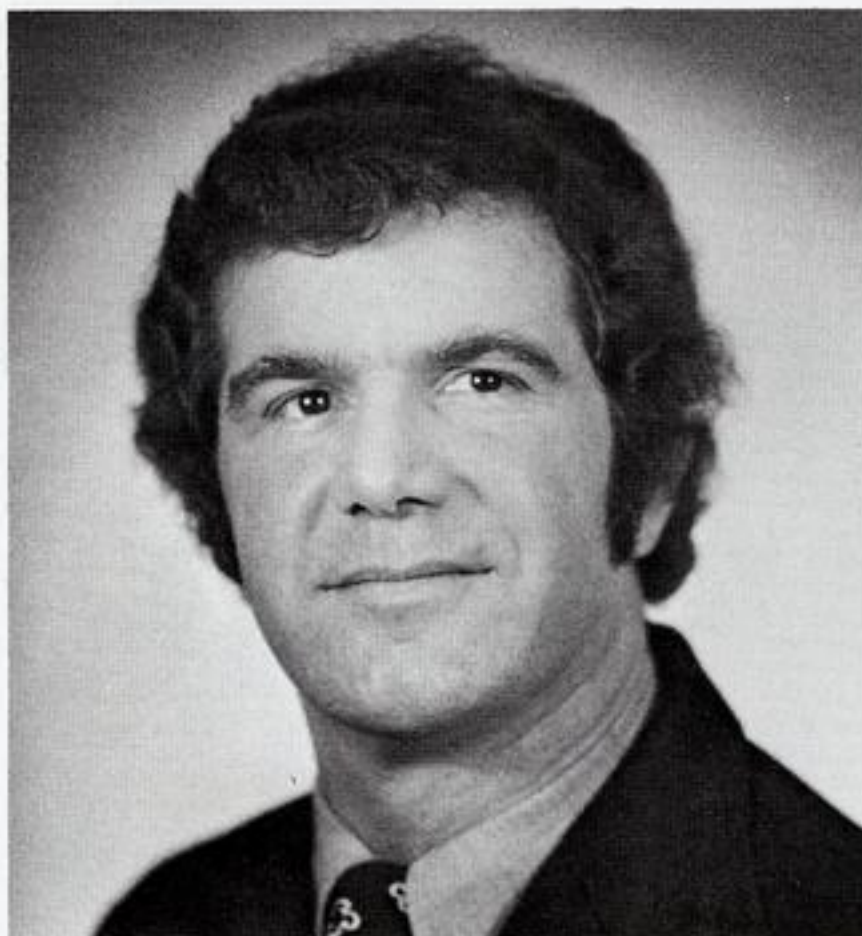

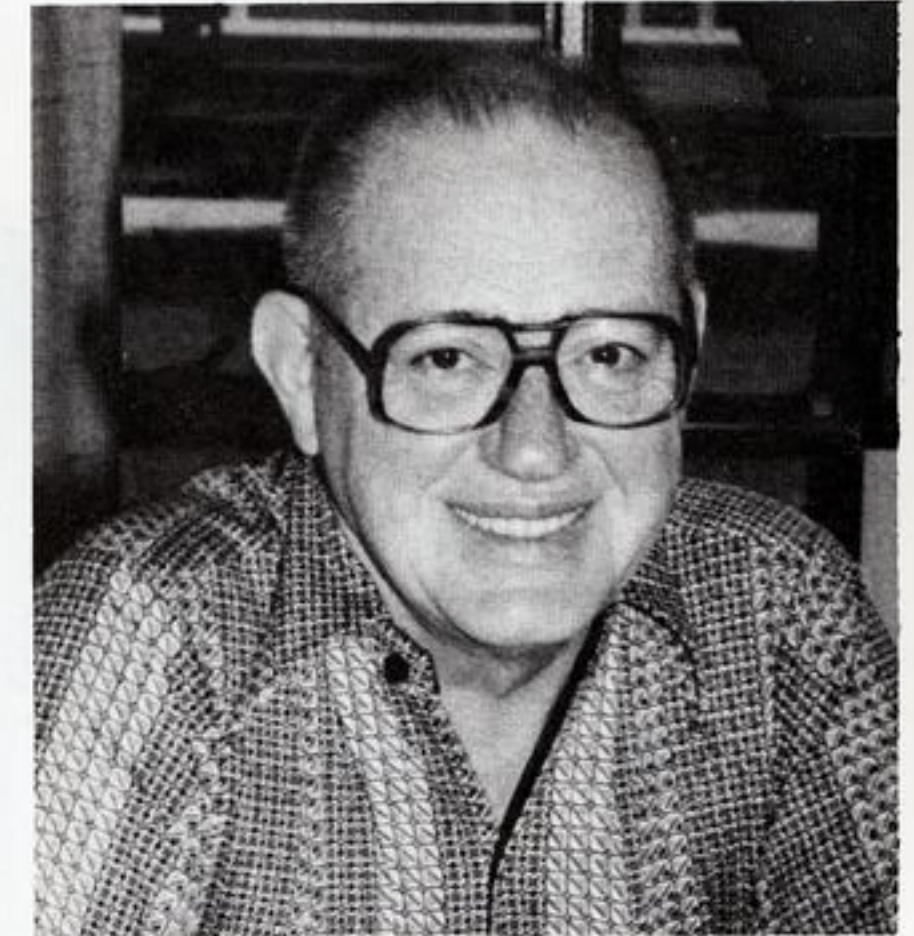
