

EXPLANATION OF TABLES.

In the table of analyses the manufacturer's guaranty is printed in bold face figures.

Table II.

In this table are classed all straight feeds, or feeds made from one grain or cereal only. The grains or cereals from which these feeds are made are given in alphabetical order and the names of the products of each grain or cereal are given in alphabetical order also.

Table III.

Table III contains a class of feeds composed of wheat and corn and their by-products, with usually from 1 to 10% of wheat screenings. The feeds in this class are composed almost wholly of wheat, but where corn product appears, corn bran is the principal ingredient and varies from a mere trace to 20 or 30%.

Brewers' and Distillers' dried grains are included in Table III. as mixed feeds.

Table IV.

In this table are included all feeds termed "Poultry feeds."

Table V.

In this table are grouped miscellaneous mixed feeds, made up of the various concentrates and in some cases containing materials not classified as concentrates found on the market and a combination of grains.

Table VI.

In this table are miscellaneous mixed feeds containing a material, or materials, of little or no feeding value.
