

The Committee on Report of the President of College composed of Messrs. Gathright, Riddell and Flourmay, reported as follows: viz.

" To the Board of Trustees.

Your committee on the President's Report beg to report that the only recommendation made therein and not acted upon was that of the appointment of a standing committee on Internal Expansion. After consideration and conference with the President your committee recommend the adoption of this recommendation, and the appointment of this as one of the standing Committees of the Board.

NATURAL HISTORY Bulletin.

We further recommend that the request of the Professors in the Department of Natural History for authority to publish a bulletin of the researches and original work of the advanced students on the Zoology, Botany and Geology of Kentucky, at an expense of not exceeding \$100.00 be referred to the Executive Committee with authority to act, if in its opinion such Bulletin should be published and the funds of the College will justify same."

On motion of Judge Hines ordered that Report of the committee be adopted.

Mr. Gathright moved that Cadet Harry Davidson, of Louisville, Ky. be excused from military duty on days when the performance of this duty prevents his enjoying the benefits derived from compensated labor.

Mr. Gooding moved to amend by striking out the words " Harry Davidson " and inserting instead the words " Any student " Amendment lost.
