20 And the sons of Shimon were, Amnon, and Rinnah, Ben-hanan, and Tilon. And the sons of Ishi were, Zoheth, and Ben-zoheth.

21 ¶ The sons of Shelah the son of Judah were, Er, the father of Le-cah, and Laadah the father of Ma-reshah, and the families of the house of them that wrought fine linen, of the house of Ashbea,

22 And Jokim, and the men of Chozeba, and Joash, and Saraph, who had the dominion in Moab, and Jashubi-lehem. And these are ancient things.

23 These were the potters, and those that dwelt among plants and hedges: there they dwelt with the king for his work.

24 ¶ The sons of Simeon were, 13 Nemuel, and Jamin, 14 Jarib, Zerah, and Shaul:

25 Shallum his son, Mibsam his son, Mishma his son.

26 And the sons of Mishma; Ham-muel his son, Zacchur his son, Shi-mei his son.

27 And Shimei had sixteen sons, and six daughters; but his brethren had not many children, neither did all their family multiply <sup>15</sup> like to the children of Judah.

28 And they dwelt at Beer-sheba, and Moladah, and Hazar-shual,

29 And at <sup>16</sup> Bilhah, and at Ezem, and at <sup>17</sup> Tolad,

30 And at Bethuel, and at Hor-mah, and at Ziklag.

31 And at Beth-marcaboth, and <sup>18</sup> Hazarsusim, and at Beth-birei, and at Shaaraim. These were their cities unto the reign of David.

32 And their villages were, <sup>19</sup> Etam, and Ain, Rimmon, and Tochen, and Ashan, five cities:

33 And all their villages that were round about the same cities, unto <sup>20</sup> Baal. These were their habitations, and <sup>21</sup> their genealogy.

34 And Meshobab, and Jamlech, and Joshah the son of Amaziah,

35 And Joel, and Jehu the son of Josibiah, the son of Seraiah, the son of Asiel,

36 And Elioenai, and Jaakobah, and Jeshohaiah, and Asaiah, and Adiel, and Jesimiel, and Binniah,

37 And Ziza the son of Shiphi, the son of Allon, the son of Jedaiiah, the son of Shimri, the son of She-maiah;

38 These <sup>22</sup> mentioned by their names were princes in their families; and the house of their fathers increased greatly.

39 ¶ And they went to the entrance of Gedor, even unto the east

side of the valley, to seek pasture for their flocks.

40 And they found fat pasture and good, and the land was wide, and quiet, and peaceable; for they of Ham had dwelt there of old.

41 And these written by name came in the days of Hezekiah king of Judah, and smote <sup>d</sup> their tents, and the habitations that were found there, and destroyed them utterly unto this day, and dwelt in their rooms: because there was pasture there for their flocks,

42 And some of them, even of the sons of Simeon, five hundred men, went to mount Seir, having for their captains Pelatiah, and Neariah, and Rephaiah, and Uzziel, the sons of Ishi.

43 And they smote the rest of the Amalekites <sup>f</sup> that were escaped, and dwelt there unto this day.

## CHAPTER V.

## The line of Reuben unto the captivity.

**N**OW the sons of Reuben the first-born of Israel, (for he <sup>a</sup> was the first-born; but, forasmuch as he <sup>b</sup> defiled his father's bed, his birthright was given <sup>c</sup> unto the sons of Joseph the son of Israel: and the genealogy is not to be reckoned after the birthright.

2 For Judah <sup>d</sup> prevailed above his brethren, and of him came the chief <sup>1</sup> ruler; but the birthright was Joseph's:)

3 The sons, <sup>e</sup> I say, of Reuben the first-born of Israel, were, Hanoch, and Pallu, Hezron, and Carmi.

4 The sons of Joel; Shemaiah his son, Gog his son, Shimei his son,

5 Micah his son, Reaia his son, Baal his son,

6 Beerah his son, whom <sup>2</sup> Til-gath-pilneser king of Assyria carried away captive: he was prince of the Reubenites.

7 And his brethren by their families, (when the genealogy of their generations was reckoned,) were the chief, Jeiel, and Zechariah,

8 And Bela the son of Azaz, the son of <sup>3</sup> Shema, the son of Joel, who dwelt in Aroer, <sup>f</sup> even unto Nebo and Baal-meon:

9 And eastward he inhabited unto the entering in of the wilderness from the river Euphrates; because their cattle were multiplied in the land of Gilead <sup>g</sup>

10 And in the days of Saul they made war with the Hagarites, <sup>h</sup> who fell by their hand: and they dwelt in their tents <sup>4</sup> throughout all the east land of Gilead.
