

17 And he said unto them, What manner of communications are these that ye have one to another, as ye walk, and are sad?

18 And the one of them, whose name was Cleopas, *k* answering said unto him, Art thou only a stranger in Jerusalem, and hast not known the things which are come to pass there in these days?

19 And he said unto them, What things? And they said unto him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a *l* prophet mighty *m* in deed and word before God and all the people:

20 And *n* now the chief priests and our rulers delivered him to be condemned to death, and have crucified him.

21 But we trusted that it had been *o* he which should have redeemed Israel: and beside all this, to-day is the third day since these things were done.

22 Yea, and certain women *p* also of our company made us astonished, which were early at the sepulchre;

23 And when they found not his body, they came, saying, that they had also seen a vision of angels, which said that he was alive.

24 And certain *q* of them which were with us went to the sepulchre, and found *it* even so as the women had said: but him they saw not.

25 Then he said unto them, *r* O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken!

26 Ought *s* not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter *t* into his glory?

27 And beginning at Moses, *u* and all the prophets, *v* he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.

28 And they drew nigh unto the village whither they went: and he *w* made as though he would have gone further.

29 But they constrained him, saying, Abide with us: for it is toward evening, and the day is far spent. And he went in to tarry with them.

30 And it came to pass, as he sat at meat with them, he *x* took bread, and blessed *it*, and brake, and gave to them.

31 And their eyes were opened, and they knew him; and he *y* vanished out of their sight.

32 And they said one to another, Did not our heart burn *y* within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened to us the scriptures?

33 And they rose up the same hour, and returned to Jerusalem, and

34 Saying, The Lord is risen indeed, and hath *z* appeared to Simon.

35 And they told what things *done* in the way, and how he was known of them in breaking bread.

36 ¶ And *a* as they thus spake, Jesus himself stood in the midst of them, and saith unto them, *Peace* be unto you.

37 But they were terrified and frightened, and supposed *b* that they had seen a spirit.

38 And he said unto them, Are ye troubled? and why are your thoughts arise in your hearts?

39 Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have.

40 And when he had thus spoken, he showed them *his* hands and feet.

41 And while they yet believed not for joy, and wondered, he shewed unto them, *Having* ye here any piece of broiled fish, and of an honeycomb?

42 And they gave him a piece of broiled fish, and of an honeycomb, and he took *it*, and did eat before them.

43 And he said unto them, These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you: all *g* things must be fulfilled in you, which are written in the law of Moses, and in the *h* prophets, and in the psalms, *i* concerning me.

44 Then opened he their understanding, that they might stand the scriptures, and said unto them, Thus it behoved *C* to suffer, and to rise *l* from the dead the third day:

45 And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

46 And ye are witnesses *n* of these things.

47 ¶ And, behold, I send *the* will of my Father upon you: tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

48 And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and he lifted up his hands, and blessed them.

49 ¶ And it came to pass, while he blessed them, he was parted from them, and carried *p* up into heaven.

50 And *q* they worshipped him, and returned to Jerusalem with joy:

51 And were continually in the temple praising *r* and blessing him.
