18 And cried when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying, What *u* city is like unto this great city!

19 And they cast dust *v* on their heads, and cried, weeping and wailing, saying, Alas, alas that great city, wherein were made rich all that had ships in the sea by reason of her costliness! for in one hour is she made desolate.

20 Rejoice *w* over her, *thou* heaven, and *ye* holy apostles and prophets; for God hath avenged *x* you on her.

21 And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast *it* into the sea, saying, Thus *y* with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found no more at all.

22 And the voice of harpers, and musicians, and of pipers, and trumpeters, shall be heard no more at all in thee; and no craftsman, of whatsoever craft *he* be, shall be found any more in thee; and the sound of a millstone *z* shall be heard no more at all in thee;

23 And the light of a candle shall shine no more at all in thee; and the voice of the bridegroom *a* and of the bride shall be heard no more at all in thee: for thy merchants *b* were the great men of the earth; for by thy sorceries *c* were all nations deceived.

24 And in her was found the blood of prophets, and of saints, and of all that were slain *d* upon the earth.

CHAPTER XIX.

10 And *r* I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, See *thou* do it not: I am thy fellow-servant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus *r* is the spirit of prophecy.

11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white *s* horse; and he that sat upon him *was* called Faithful *t* and True, and in righteousness *u* he doth judge and make war.

12 His *v* eyes *were* as a flame of fire, and on his head *were* many crowns; *w* and he had a name *x* written, that no man knew but he himself.

13 And he *was* clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The *y* Word of God.

14 And the armies *which were* in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed *z* in fine linen, white and clean.

15 And out of his mouth *d* goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod *b* of iron: and he *c* treadeth the wine-press of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

16 And he hath on *his* vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING *d* OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come *e* and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;
