I would not let any barrel with as much as 5 ~~barrels~~ gallons out go off but would fill them up. It may be as well to send Wm Price & Co part of this lot but I cannot say that I will ship to them until I get a letter from them stating rate of charges &c.

Ship to Newcomb Buchanan & Co as fast as you can get Car loads to Depot as I want to draw more money from them next week. Please write me when you want Col. Tompkins to go down to take out the bale of this 500 bl. say 205 you can make your calculation when you can get the 295 to Depot. Mr. Higgins has got home and I am going down there in the morning to settle matters with him.
