

**WATER FACILITIES:**  
Two large ponds, seven special fire cisterns and private cisterns. Cisterns filled by engine from ponds.

**FIRE DEPT.:**  
18 paid men, 2 men on duty at Eng. Ho. at all times. 1 steam fire engine, 1 four wheeled hose wagon carrying 1000' 2 1/2" cotton rubber lined hose. 1 four wheeled ladder truck. Total ft. hose 1650' 2 1/2" good, 1000' 2 1/2" fairly good. Alarm given by telephone, sounded by bell on "Fire Eng. Ho." grades about level.
