

**C**HARLES GORHAM, Logan County, Ky., fought at Shiloh, Vicksburg, Baton Rouge, Hartsville, Murfreesboro', Jackson, Chickamauga, Mission Ridge, Rocky Face Gap, and Resaca; from Resaca to Atlanta; at Peachtree, Intrenchment, and Uttoy Creeks, and at Jonesboro'. He was killed at the latter place.

**W.** F. HENRY, Logan County, Ky., fought at Shiloh, Vicksburg, Baton Rouge, Hartsville, Murfreesboro', Jackson, Chickamauga, Mission Ridge, Rocky Face Gap, and Resaca; from Resaca to Atlanta; and at Peachtree and Intrenchment Creeks. He was captured at the latter place, and did not return in time to take part in the closing engagements.

**M**OSES H. HESTER, Logan County, Ky., took part in most of the engagements of his company, and was wounded at Peachtree Creek, July 20, 1864.

**G.** M. D. HESTER, Logan County, Ky., was wounded in battle at Shiloh, and disabled, in consequence of which he was soon afterward discharged.

**D**AVID HERRING, Logan County, Ky., fought at Shiloh, Vicksburg, Baton Rouge, Hartsville, Murfreesboro', Jackson, Chickamauga, and Mission Ridge.

**I**SAAC HUNTER, Logan County, Ky., fought at Shiloh, Vicksburg, Hartsville, and Murfreesboro'.

**G**EORGE HARPER, Logan County, Ky., fought at Shiloh, Vicksburg, Baton Rouge, Hartsville, Murfreesboro', Jackson, and Chickamauga, and shortly after the latter engagement, he died of disease at Dalton.

**S**AMUEL HOBBS, was enlisted at Augusta, Ga., in the autumn of 1864, and took part in all the subsequent engagements.

**R.** M. HOGAN, Logan County, Ky., took part in nearly all the engagements, and was wounded at Resaca.

**W.** T. HARDISON, Logan County, Ky., was discharged, November, 1862, being under age.

**U**RIAH JOHNSON, Logan County, Ky., was killed in battle at Shiloh, April 6, 1862.

**W**ILLIAM KING, Logan County, Ky., participated in most of the engagements up to Resaca, and was killed there, May 14, 1864.

**G**EORGE KING, Logan County, Ky., fought at Shiloh, and was wounded there.
