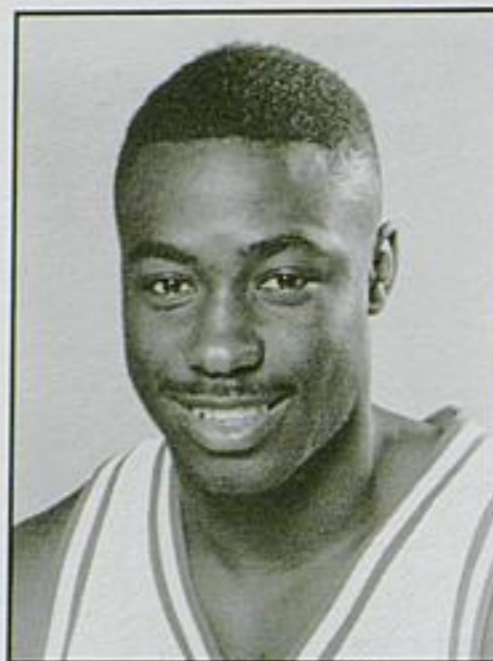

GENERAL

Excellent three-point shooter and defensive player ... Received the Best Defensive Player award for the team in 1991-92 ... One of the best all-around athletes on the team ... Attended high school with Florida football player Shane Matthews and former Florida State star Terrell Buckley ... Was born in Baton Rouge, La., home of LSU coach Dale Brown.

1991-92

Had a career-high 24 points vs. Arizona State in a game that included six straight three-pointers ... Scored 21 against Georgia Tech to be named to the five-member Kuppenheimer All-Classic Team ... Excellent game vs. Duke in East Regional finals; 18 points (3-5 from three-point range), three rebounds in 30 minutes ... Had 16 points, including three three-pointers, vs. Louisville ... 18 points against Georgia came on a perfect performance — 7-7 from the field, 4-4 from three-point range ... That performance earned him SEC Rookie of the Week honors.

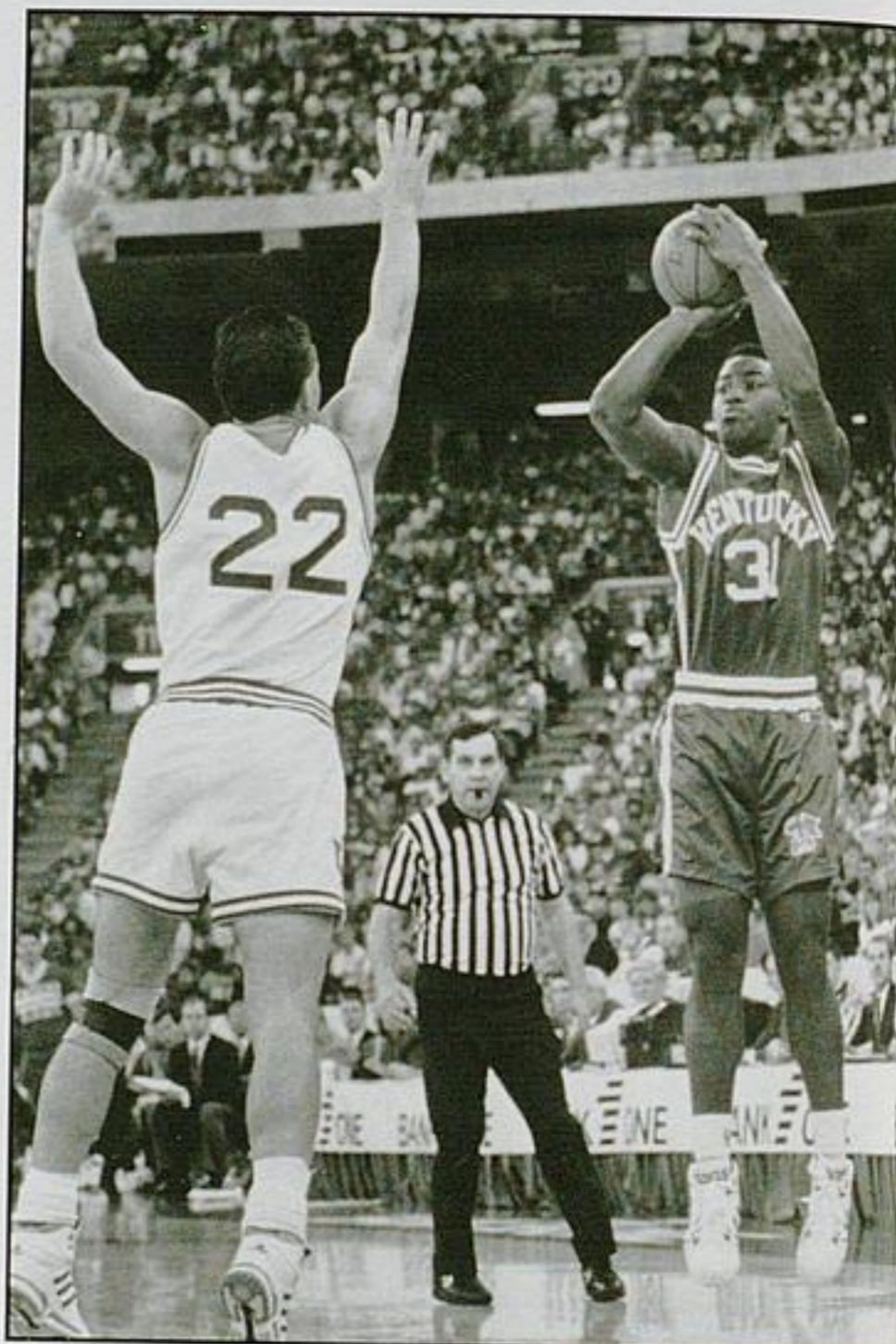
HIGH SCHOOL/JUCO

Averaged 20 points, 5.8 rebounds and six assists per game as a sophomore at Mississippi Gulf Coast Junior College ... 1990-91 first team Junior College All-

America selection ... Hit seven three-pointers in a game against Delgado Junior College for the regional championship ... An outside shooting specialist, he averaged 18 points, six rebounds and four assists his first season at Gulf Coast ... Attended Pascagoula High School, where he was team captain and an All-State selection ... Coached by Bob Weathers in Junior College, David Lipscomb in high school.
