fundamental thing of all athletic training is to build up character."

"The team is going to be developed out of the whole student body. We will have to get down to the very basis of what constitutes the fundamentals in athletics—student's support.

"I know of men who came here to try to keep strict training but couldn't. If athletics must mean anything, men must adhere to training and discipline. These are the very factors that make athletics of so great importance in student life. Girl's can do a tremendous amount of good in the way of developing athletic teams. If they will just bear in mind that the men must not smoke, drink or keep late hours the sentiment that is behind that is going to enforce those regulations.

"I hope to have just as many men out as possible. There will be competition from within but it will be under one control and under the same rules of training. If we can accomplish this at the University we will have a type of men to produce the type of football team that we want to produce.

"If I can get you in the frame of mind that the team is "OURS" we can get some good out of it. If I can get the student body to act as a strong support to the men who are trying to live up to training rules, then we will have an aggregation which can not be beaten. The essence of football is to have the spirit of the men individually backed up with the spirit of the institution."
