ACCI. 174-C - GEORGE LAWS - APR. 15-1927.

Fatally injured in Virginia in automobile accident before he could be returned to work. Balance of compensation due - \$8.57. Compensation board advised that money must be paid to duly qualified administrator. Widow does not wish to go to the expense. Mr. Sampson recommends paying \$8.57 to widow on regular receipt form and closing the case.

ACCI. 192-C - W. W. HEADDEN - MAY 23, 1927.

FATAL- Compensation board allowed widow and daughter compensation on basis of total dependency. Company appealed case to courts. Will be heard probably sometime this summer. Defendant will claim that widow's conduct was such as that its legal effect was that she had abandoned the decedent and not sufficient proof upon which to base the conclusion found by the Board that child was dependent.

ACCI. 227-C - JOS. PARROTT - JAN. 2, 1928.

FATAL- Claim of ~~her~~ alleged wife of deceased denied by Board. Still the matter of \$100.00 to dispose of. Should this be paid to children. 2 children in Benham.

ACCI. 234-C - FRANK ROSE (MRS. C. C. WHEELER)-

FATAL- Pending before Compensation Board.

ACCI. 268-C - AARON MCGLAMERY - SEPT. 13, 1928.

Double compound comminuted fractures both bones both legs lower third. Dr. Britton says anything up to 50% of body-Dr. Lyons 35% body-Dr. Todd 21% to body.

ACCI. 280-C - TOM TRENT - APR. 17, 1929.

Fracture of right pelvis with upward dislocation. Dr. Todd says able to return to very light work now. Dr. Britton says wait three or four months longer. Dr. T. says 25 to 35% to body-Dr. Britton says nearly, if not a total. Dr. Beggs thinks somewhere in between.

ACCI. 282-C - FRANK POORE - APR. 26, 1929.

Slight fracture upper portion of second lumbar vertebrae. Old injury Jan. 3, 1924 while working for Climax Coal Company on account of which Board awarded him 60% disability. Returned to work May 27, 1929. ~~He~~ Put on coal loading Nov. 19, 1929 making more money than before injury. Refuses to settle for less than \$150.00. Dr. Beggs says no disability. Mr. Sampson recommends letting case go before Compensation Board.

ACCI. 291-C - WILL WASHINGTON - JUNE 21, 1929.

Fracture of lower third right femur. Died of cardiac decompensation Sept. 12th. See report of Dr. T. dated September 14th, 1929. Thirteen days comp. due.

ACCI. 295-C - RILEY CAUDILL - JULY 17, 1929.

Simple fracture left femur lower third. Returned to light work Jan. 6, 1930 to regular work loading coal Feb. 8th. Practically no disability-little impairment ~~XXXXX~~ of flexing. Probably 10% to leg. Can be settled.

ACCI. 298-C - GEO. E. SMITH - July 19, 1929.

Compression fracture second lumbar vertebrae Able to return to work in two or three months. Disability slight probably 15 to 20%.
