## SODOMY APPEAL REJECTED

Fayette Circuit Judge Charles M. Tackett has dismissed the county's appeal of a decision holding unconstitutional Kentucky's consensual sodomy law.

Earlier this year, District Judge Lewis Paisley declared the sodomy statute unconstitutional, holding that it violated the right to privacy under the Kentucky Constitution. In so doing, Judge Paisley agreed with arguments submitted by ACLU/KY Cooperating Attorney Ernesto Scorsone that the Kentucky Constitution offers broader privacy protection than the U.S. Constitution. (The U.S. Supreme Court had earlier rejected, by a 5-4 vote, the argument that the right of privacy under the U.S. Constitution rendered unconstitutional Georgia's sodomy statute.)

The circuit court did not rule on the merits of Fayette County's appeal. Rather it held that any appeal had to be brought by the attorney general, not the county attorney. Fayette County has asked Judge Tackett to reconsider his decision. Further appeal is considered likely.
