

for room and board with two meals a day (breakfast and dinner); or \$976 for two meals a day (lunch and dinner).

### Graduates

Graduate rates in Cooperstown are \$524 for an efficiency apartment and \$614 for a one-bedroom apartment for the academic year (may be extended to include summer session without additional charge). The rate for single occupancy in Cooperstown is \$1048 for an efficiency and \$1228 for a one-bedroom unit.

The rates for graduate students DO NOT include meals. Meal contracts cost \$515 for the three-meal plan; \$401 for the two-meal plan (breakfast and dinner); or \$461 for the two-meal plan (lunch and dinner).

### Board Only

Contracts for board only are also available to students residing off-campus. The rate is \$515 per year for a three-meal contract plan; \$401 for the two-meal plan (breakfast and dinner); or \$461 for the two-meal plan (lunch and dinner).

### First Installment

The first installment of \$100 must accompany the student's application. This installment, as well as subsequent payments, must be made by mail to the Housing Office, Box 999, University of Kentucky, Lexington, Kentucky 40506. In addition to the room and board rate, an activity fee of \$5.00 per semester, used to support student-managed programs in the residence halls, is collected at the beginning of the school year by the Residence Hall Programming Staff.

### Payments

Because of limited space in the Housing Office for collecting fees, payments for room and board must be mailed to the University Housing Office, Box 999, University of Kentucky, Lexington, Kentucky 40506. Receipts will be mailed to the student's permanent address.

### Rate Changes

Upon action taken by the Board of Trustees, rates are subject to change at any time prior to the beginning of the academic year.

### Loans

Loan funds may be obtained through private lending agencies. Further information on these funds may be mailed to the student by the lending institution after his acceptance for admission to the University.

The contractual arrangement in such loans is between the student or parent and the lending institution. Information regarding financial aid can be obtained from the Student Financial Aid Office, University of Kentucky, Lexington, Kentucky 40506.

## Cancellations and Refunds

*Before the semester begins:*

1. A \$90 refund of initial payment will be made if notice to cancel a room reservation is given in writing to the Housing Office on or before June 1, 1971 for the fall applicant, or December 1, 1971 for spring applicants.
2. No refund will be made if cancellation of a room reservation is requested after June 1, 1971 for the Fall Semester, or after December 1, 1971 for the Spring Semester.
3. \$90 will be refunded if a student is rejected for admission to the University.
4. No refund will be made for applications submitted and cancelled after June 1, 1971 for the Fall Semester, or after December 1, 1971 for the Spring Semester.
5. Kentucky students who are accepted by the University, but who are advised to attend another school, may receive a \$90 refund if they cancel prior to the cancellation deadline. After the cancellation deadline, there will be no refund of the \$100 first installment.

*After the semester begins:*

Regular semester (16 weeks): Students living in the residence halls who withdraw from the University of Kentucky will be assessed a charge for room and board of \$100 through the first three weeks, plus a charge computed at the rate of eight percent of the total semester charge for each week in residence through the 12th week. Any fractional part of a week will be considered a full week.

Students withdrawing from the residence halls to enter married student housing units will be assessed a charge for room and board at the rate of six and a quarter percent of the total semester charge for each week in residence. Any fractional part of a week will be considered a full week.

Students are urged to submit the housing application at the time they apply for admission to the University in order to establish an early consideration date.
